

UP TO 350 MORE HOUSES ON MOORWAY LANE? SAY NO TO OVER DEVELOPMENT OBJECT BY 10 NOVEMBER



What's Happening?

A planning application has been submitted for up to 350 houses on Moorway Lane. This means more traffic, pressure on schools and GP surgeries, and loss of a key green wedge. Greener Littleover are coordinating a community response to enable our voices to be heard.

Why Object?

Increased congestion and pollution. Impact on natural habitats, loss of local character and green space. Strain on local services, schools, and public services.

Unsuitable transport links and infrastructure.

Deadline:

We want to get to over 1000 objections to this scheme. Multiple objections can be submitted per household. Copy in your local councillors and MP where possible. **Submit your objection by 10 November!**
